Class Fees and Annual Pledge

First Unitarian Society is committed to ensuring that all families and their children can participate in our Religious Education Program regardless of their family's ability to pay. However, the cost of our program is substantial and we encourage all parents who are able to participate in supporting it financially.

- **Class Fees:** Families who are able to, are asked to pay a per-child fee (see fee table below). We are pleased to offer a full or partial scholarship to your family if you find these fees an undue burden.
- **Annual Pledge:** Families who are in their first year are automatically granted a pledge waiver to have time to determine whether or not FUS feels right as their spiritual home. Families who decide to re-register their child(ren) in our CRE program for a second year or more are required to make a financial pledge to the FUS community *before registering*. We encourage you to pledge an amount to our Annual Campaign that aligns with your family's resources. Pledges can be distributed in monthly payments for your convenience. _____ **Teacher:** Teachers are our greatest need and an excellent way to contribute to our community. Most of our classes are taught by a team of four teachers, with two scheduled at each session. Our classes use a provided curriculum that outlines the day's lesson. All materials and supplies are provided. *For new teachers for pre-K through 5th grade: Teacher Orientation is on Saturday, August 17th from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Teachers of 6th – 9th grade will be notified later of their training date.*
